After hearing learned Senior Counsel extensively, when we expressed our disinclination to grant relief in this application, the learned Senior Counsel for the Applicant, prays for unconditional withdrawal of this application. But he made a request that since the Applicant is in custody since 08/07/2018, liberty be granted to renew his prayer for bail within a reasonable time, if his Appeal is not heard finally.
