IN INTERIM APPLICATION NO. 4184 OF 2025:

1. For the reasons stated in the application and the fact that the applicant has previously been permitted to travel abroad on 17 occasions, permission is hereby granted to the applicant to travel abroad from 5 December 2025 to 15 February 2026. The
