1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. On 24 April 2025, at the request of Mr. Jamsheed Master who appeared on behalf of the Petitioner, we adjourned the matter only because he informed us that an SLP had been filed against order dated 11 March 2025 made by the learned Single Judge and that was to come up for hearing on 25 April 2025. Mr. Master also stated that even if, for

any reason, the SLP does not come up, this petition would be withdrawn with liberty to apply for restoration in case the Special Leave Petition were to be allowed.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court dismissed the SLP on 25 April 2025. As such, it was expected that the Petitioner would not press this petition any further and gracefully withdraw it or allow it to be disposed of.

4. Instead, the Petitioner, by engaging a different counsel, now points out that a review petition has been filed against the order dated 25 April 2025 before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. He now suggests that liberty should be granted to revive this petition if the review petition is allowed.

5. Aside from this unfortunate exercise of going back on a solemn statement made to this Court by changing counsel, we believe this is merely an attempt to keep the pot boiling. If the review is allowed, the consequences will follow, and the orders in review will have to be complied with by all concerned. But as pointed out by Mr. Naphade, nothing survives in this petition, particularly after the learned Single Judge's order dated 11 March 2025. Not even an attempt was made to argue that anything survives. There is no point in pending this petition any further. There was no justification to recant the statement earlier made. The Petitioner must pay some costs.

6. For all the above reasons, we dismiss this petition. The Interim Application does not survive and is disposed of.

7. The Petition is dismissed after recording and accepting Mr. Soman's statement made on instructions that the Petitioner would

donate Rs.25,000/- to the Government K.E.M. Hospital within four weeks from today and file a compliance report soon thereafter.
