1. Heard Mr. Dinesh Gulabani for Appellant and Ms. Ritu Punjabi for Respondent.
2. The tax effect in this case is less than Rs. 2 crore. Accordingly, we dispose of this Appeal on the ground of low tax effect by keeping open the question of law raised.
3. If, at later stage, Appellant realizes that tax effect is greater than Rs. 2 crore or that subject-matter falls within any of the exception, liberty is granted to apply for restoration/revival. This is provided where the Application for restoration/revival is filed within reasonable time, i.e. on or before 31st January, 2026.
