1. Mr. Sharma, learned Counsel for the Appellant , based on instructions, seeks leave to withdraw this Appeal on the ground that the tax effect is less than Rs. 2 Crores.
2. Accordingly, we permit the withdrawal and dispose of the Appeal as withdrawn , leaving open all the questions of law raised in the Appeal.

3. If, at any stage, it is found that the tax effect is greater than Rs. 2 Crores or that the matter falls within any of the exceptions to the CBDT Circular, liberty is granted to apply for revival within a reasonable time, i.e., on or before 31st January 2026.
