1. This is an application under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking an extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal, which expired on September 25, 2020.

2. Today, when the matter is called out, Learned Counsel for the parties jointly submit that this would be the first extension, and jointly request for an extension of mandate by a period of twelve months, bearing in mind the stage at which the arbitral proceedings are placed.

3. In these circumstances, taking into account the stage at which the Arbitral proceedings are placed, this Petition is ***finally disposed of*** extending the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal for a period of twelve months from today i.e. until ***February 13, 2026***.
