In this writ petition challenge has been raised to an order dated 11th September 2024 passed by the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal permitting objections to be filed to the Commissioner's report. An alternate prayer for expeditious disposal of Appeal Nos.18 of 2024 and 27 of 2024 pending before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal has also been made.

2. Out attention is invited to the order dated 5th March 2024 passed in Writ Petition (Lodging) No.4131 of 2024 (*HAQ Steels & Mataliks Ltd. Vs. Adi Impex Infra Services & Ors.*) with connected Writ Petition (Lodging)

No.29735 of 2023. This Court has directed expeditious consideration of the aforesaid proceedings. It is informed that the present petitioner has also filed an interim application bearing No.606 of 2023 with various interim prayers, which was disposed of on 9th January 2024 on the ground that the proceedings in the appeal would be heard on merits.

3. In aforesaid facts, since this Court has already directed expeditious consideration of the said proceedings by an order dated 5th March 2024, the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal shall take all steps to ensure that both the appeals are decided expeditiously. These directions are issued subject to all parties to the proceedings co-operating in disposal of the proceedings. In case adjudication of the said appeals is not possible, it is open for the petitioner to revive the prayers made in Interim Application No.606 of 2023. By clarifying that all points on merits are kept open, the writ petition is disposed of.
