6. Advocate for Petitioner to effect service of Citation as per **Rule 397** of the rules and to file Affidavit of service within two weeks after

issuance of Citation.

7. Administration Bond for the gross amount to be furnished vide **form no. 118 r/w Rule 420** of the Bombay High Court (O.S.) Rules, 1980, within three weeks alongwith the name of Surety and address and proofs thereof.

8. Advocate to carry out corrections, if any, however, Advocate has to affix signature and date thereon.
