PC : 1. Perused Petition. Heard Ld. Advocate for petitioner. This petition is for Succession Certificate in respect of certain securities belonging to deceased filed by petitioner namely Bhavika Kaushal Shah being daughter-in-law of deceased. Deceased namely Nayana Chandrakant Shah died intestate at Mumbai on 05.01.2002. Copy of death certificate is annexed to the petition. Identification proof of deceased viz. copy of Pancard is already annexed to the petition.

2. Ld. Advocate for petitioner submits that parents of deceased predeceased the deceased. One son of deceased namely Kaushal died leaving behind his widow and one minor daughter. Deceased was survived by husband and daughter-in-law and minor granddaughter. Out of them daughter-in-law is petitioner herein and husband has given his consent in favour of the petitioner herein. As regards minor granddaughter namely Saachi petitioner has filed consent Affidavit dated 25.07.2025 being mother and natural guardian on her behalf. There are no other legal heirs.

3. Petitioner's oath is filed. Affidavit of Service of affixation of General Notice dated 17.04.2025 and Administration Bond dated 29.03.2025 are filed. Delay is explained and same is condoned. All other legal formalities are complied with. Hence, petition is granted.

4. Office to issue Succession Certificate as prayed after verifying whether any cross petition is filed or whether any Affidavit opposing grant is filed.
