- 2.** Present Testamentary Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of Letters of Administration under Section 278 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Hemantkumar @ Hemant Chaturbhuj Pursnani . The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph Nos. 7, 8 and 9 of the Petition.
