Deceased had divorced to the first wife. Copy of divorce decree passed by the 5th Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai in Petition No. F. 1230 of 2021 is annexed to the petition as Exhibit - “D”. Deceased was survived by mother and two daughters. Out of them mother is petitioner herein and both daughters have given their consents. Consent Affidavits are on record. There are no other legal heirs.
3. Petitioner's oath is filed. Affidavit of Service of affixation of General Notice dated 03.02.2025 and Administration Bond is filed dated 30.01.2025 are filed. Delay is explained. All other legal formalities are complied with. Hence, petition is granted.
4. Office to issue Succession Certificate as prayed after verifying whether any cross petition is filed or whether any Affidavit opposing grant is filed.
