1. Mr Sharma, the learned Counsel for the Appellant, on instructions seeks leave to withdraw this Appeal on the grounds of low tax effect. He however submits that liberty may be given to seek restoration if the tax effect is found to be more than Rs. 2 Crores or the Appeal falls within any of the exceptions.
