) In reply, ld. Advocate appearing for respondent
) nos. 4 to 9 submits that the reason putforth by
) the applicants for restoration of the captioned
) Appeal by setting aside Orders as aforesaid, is
) not bonafide and therefore, seeks rejection of
) the Chamber Order.

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I have considered submissions as canvassed by ld. Advocates appearing for the applicants and respondent nos. 4 to 9. The reasons appear to be bonafide and an opportunity to contest the matter on merits needs to be given to the applicants. Hence, the present Chamber Order needs to be allowed by condoning delay of 10 days, caused in filing present Chamber Order.
