2. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the disputes between the plaintiff and defendant have been settled and that the consent terms have been executed.

3. The consent terms signed by the constituted attorney of plaintiffs as well as defendant and the advocate for the plaintiff, are tendered. The same are taken on record and marked 'X'.

4. Copy of Aadhar Card of the defendant is annexed to the consent terms . The defendant has agreed to submit to a decree in terms of prayer clauses (a) to (d).

5. It is brought to the notice of this Court that a demand draft for an amount of ₹ 1 lakh is received by the plaintiff. In fact, the matter

has been urgently mentioned for disposal, in the light of the fact that today is the last working day before summer vacation and the said demand draft would be expiring on 25.05.2025 i.e. during the summer vacation.

6. Suit is disposed of as per the consent terms. Decree be drawn up accordingly.

7. Leave petition is allowed by consent.

8. The undertakings recorded in the consent terms are accepted as undertakings to this Court. Parties are directed to abide by their respective obligations, as per the consent terms.

9. A soft copy of the consent terms shall be uploaded as second order in the matter. A hard copy of duly signed consent terms shall be retained in the record and shall not be sent for destruction in the usual course.

10. The Court fees shall be refunded as per rules. For the purpose of Section 43 of the Maharashtra Court Fees Act and the proviso thereto, today's date shall be the date of making a claim for repayment. The Prothonotary and Senior Master shall proceed to issue a certificate for refund of Court fees, on the basis of an authenticated copy of this order, without insisting upon a separate application.

11. In view of the disposal of the suit, pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
