1. This Court is informed that the suit has been settled between the parties. The Consent Terms are tendered which are taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.

2. The Consent Terms are executed by the authorised representative of the Plaintiffs and the proprietor of the Defendant. The Defendant is present in Court and reiterates the terms of the Consent Terms.

3. He submits to a decree on admission in terms of prayer clause (a) and (b) of the plaint. The statements made in the Consent Terms is accepted as undertaking given to this Court. The identity of the Defendant is verified from his Aadhar Card and by his Pan Card which are placed on record.
