ORDER :

1. These are the Petitions under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking an extension of mandate of the Learned Arbitral Tribunal, which expired on September 9, 2025.

2. None appears for the Petitioner. However, Learned Counsel for the Respondent is present and submits that the parties have consensus to extend the mandate by a further period of six months. Therefore, without waiting for the Advocate for the Petitioner, the mandate is hereby extended.

3. In these circumstances, taking into account the stage at which the arbitral proceedings are placed, this Petition is ***finally disposed of***

extending the mandate of the Learned Arbitral Tribunal for a period of *six months*, rounding it up until *April 30, 2026*.
