1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. After this matter was argued for some time, learned counsel for the Petitioners, based on instructions seeks leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to appeal the impugned order dated 24 December 2024. Mr. Namboodiri states that if liberty is granted, the appeal would be instituted within eight weeks from today. He also request that since the Petitioners, based on legal advice, was pursuing this petition, the period spent in this Court may be excluded for determining limitation.
3. We grant the Petitioners leave to withdraw this petition with liberty as prayed for.
4. Further, if the Petitioners prefers an appeal within eight weeks from today, then, in the peculiar facts of this case since the Petitioners were pursuing this petition based on legal advice, we direct the Tribunal to consider the matter on merits without advertting to the issue of

limitation. All contentions of all parties on the merits of the matter are however, left open.

5. We clarify that this order will apply only to the two Petitioners before us.

6. This Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty and directions in the above terms. No costs.
