1. Heard Mr. Mane, learned Advocate for Petitioners.
2. Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased abovenamed. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 9 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
3. Consent affidavits of the other legal heirs are filed on record and appended at page Nos. 42-67 of Petition.

4. In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clauses '(a) and (b) which read thus:-

"(a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate be issued under the provision of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827 Certifying that (1) Sushila Premnarayan Kushwaha (Married Daughter of the deceased), (2) Jamuna Devi Harinarayan Kushwaha (Married Daughter of the deceased), (3) Ranjana Mangalprasad Kushwaha (Unmarried Daughter of the Deceased and the Petitioner No.1 herein), (4) Kishan Mangal Prasad Kushwaha (Son of the Deceased), (5) Rani Ramesh Kumar Kushwaha (Daughter-in-Law of the Deceased and the Petitioner No.2 herein), (6) Ravi Rameshkumar Kushwaha (Grand Son of the Deceased and the Petitioner No.3 herein), (7) Jayashree Rameshkumar Kushwaha (Grand Daughter of the Deceased) and (8) Manish Rameshkumar Kushwaha (Grand Son of the Deceased), are the only heirs and Legal representative of the deceased.

(b) That issuance of Proclamation be dispensed with.

5. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

6. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

7. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department.
