- 1.** Heard Ms. Manjalkar , learned Advocate for Petitioner.
- 2.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Saraswatiben @ Saraswati Panalal Shah . The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 6 of the Petition. I have perused the same.
- 3.** Petitioner is the sole legal heir of the deceased.
- 4.** In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clause 'a' which read thus:-

‘(a) That a Legal Heirship Certificate certifying that the Petitioner is the only heirs and legal representative of the said deceased under the provision of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827;’

5. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.
6. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.
7. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department.
