- 2.** Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of legal heirship certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased Malathy Vaniyambeth Achuthan alias Malathy Achuthan alias Malthy Achuthan alias Malathy V. Achuthan. The names and details of legal heirs of the deceased are stated in paragraph No. 4 of the Petition. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in paragraph No. 7 of the Petition. “a. This Hon’ble Court be pleased to issue a Legal Heirship Certificate to the Petitioner under the provisions of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 certifying that (1) Shanthini Vaniyambeth Achuthan alias Shanthini V. Achuthan (2) Shobha Sreenivasan (3) Anuja Satish Achuthan and (4) Girish Vaniyambeth Achuthan alias Girish V. Achuthan as mentioned in para no.4 herein above, are the only heirs and legal representatives of the deceased.”

5. Issuance of proclamation stands dispensed with.

6. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

7. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
