2. Heard Ms. Patil, learned Advocate for Petitioner.
3. Present Misc. Petition is filed by Petitioner for issuance of Legal Heirship Certificate under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 in respect of the properties and credits of deceased abovenamed. Petitioner is the sole legal heir of the deceased. Purpose for filing the present Petition is stated in the Petition. I have perused the same.
4. In view of the above, there can be no impediment in allowing the Petition. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed of in terms of prayer clauses (a) and (b) which read thus:-

"a. This Hon'ble Court be pleased to issue a Legal Heirship Certificate to the Petitioner under the provision of Bombay Regulation Act,

*VIII of 1827 certifying that following persons i.e. **Ramchandra Vasant Dhumak** (son) is the only legal heir of the deceased abovenamed i.e. **Vasant Sakharam Dhumak**."*

b. That issuance of Proclamation be dispensed with.

5. Department is directed to issue the legal heirship certificate as directed above within a period of 3 weeks from today positively.

6. Misc. Petition is allowed and disposed subject to compliance of office objections, if any, forthwith which shall be allowed by the Department. It is clarified that the 3 week period shall start from the date of removal of office objections.
