**ORDER :**

1. This is a Petition under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking an extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal, which expired on August 7, 2025.

2. Today, when the matter is called out, Learned Counsel for the parties jointly submit that this is the second extension and request for an extension of mandate until March 2026 from today, bearing in mind the stage at which the arbitral proceedings are placed.

In these circumstances, taking into account the stage at which the Arbitral proceedings are placed, this Petition is *finally disposed of* extending the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal until ***March 31, 2026***.
