6 In view of the disposal of the Suit, the Court Receiver's Report is disposed of. The Court Receiver stands discharged without passing of accounts. All costs, charges and expenses of the Court Receiver to be paid by the Plaintiff within a period of eight (8) days of demand being raised by the Officer of the Court Receiver.

7 By consent, Leave Petition is allowed.

8 All the pending Interim Applications stand disposed of.
