1. When the matter is called out, Mr. Sathaye, learned Counsel
appears for the Plaintiff and seeks to tender across the bar affidavit in
reply dated 5th August, 2025, submitting that copy of the same has
already been furnished to the Interim Applicants/Defendants.

2. Ms. Taly, learned Counsel appears for the Applicants/Defendants
No. 1 and 2 and submits that this Court may permit amendments to the
Interim Application in terms of the draft amendments to include a
prayer for setting aside the order of the Prothonotary & Senior Master,
