1. The above Interim Application is filed seeking a condonation of
delay of 30 days and to restore the above Writ Petition to the file of this

Court. The other relief sought is to dispense with the 1st objection raised by the Registry regarding furnishing the Power of Attorney/Authority Letter/Board Resolution of the erstwhile developer and whose services have now been terminated by the Society and consequently, the Developer has been deleted as Petitioner No.2 in the above Writ Petition.
