1) The only grievance which is being raised is that impugned order imposes huge financial burden upon the petitioners. The issue whether Over Time Allowance should be a part of wages has already been decided by the Madras High Court in Writ Petition No.609/2011 against which Special Leave Petition is pending before the Hon'ble Apex Court. In a similar issue before the Delhi High Court, the benefits have been directed to be granted, subject to the outcome of the SLP. In the impugned order, also a similar course of action has been followed. We therefore, do not see any reason to interfere in impugned the order only on the ground that it creates huge financial burden.

2) The petition is therefore dismissed. No costs.
