1. By this application, the applicant is seeking condonation of delay, which is caused in preferring the revision application, challenging the order of maintenance.

2. Heard learned counsel, Mr. A.C. Dharmadhikari for the applicant. He submitted that only one day's delay was caused in preferring the appeal, i.e. due to the inadvertence on the part of the learned counsel.

3. Hence, considering the reasons mentioned in the application, which appear to be just and satisfactory. Though learned counsel for the non-applicants have objected for the same, the reasons mentioned in the application appear to be reasonable and just cause for condonation of delay.
