- 1) Learned counsel for the applicant has invited my attention to the order passed by this Court on 21/04/2023 which reads as follows :-

“Heard Mr. Abhyankar, learned counsel for the applicants.

2. It is contended, that an order under Section 9 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 has been passed by the National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai permitting the initiation of corporate insolvency resolution process against the present non-applicants.
