Civil Application (CAF) No.768/2025

Since the claimants are major, this Court deems it appropriate to permit the claimants to withdraw the amount as directed by the Tribunal in terms of Clause (7) of the order.

5. Needless to clarify that the withdrawal of Rs.10,00,000/- each shall be with accrued interest.
6. This Court permits the claimants to withdraw 75% of the amount with accrued interest.
