1. Heard Mr.Samarth, the learned counsel representing the Petitioner/Applicant and Mr.D.V. Chauhan, Senior Counsel/GP for Respondent Nos.1 to 4.

2. By Civil Application No.222/2025, the Petitioner seek withdrawal of the Petition and it is stated that after the Court has closed the matter for Judgment, Zilla Parishad has been dissolved and, therefore, the prayers in the Writ Petition do not survive.

3. A copy of the Civil Application is served upon the office of Government Pleader and Mr.D.V. Chauhan, Senior Counsel/GP has marked his appearance.
