1. This is an application for relaxation of condition.
2. By order dated 24.10.2024, this Court permitted respondent nos.1 and 2 to withdraw 50% of decretal amount on usual undertaking and 25% on furnishing solvent surety alongwith accrued interest thereon.
3. The contention is that the land of entire village has been acquired and therefore, respondent nos.1 and 2 are unable to furnish solvent surety.
4. Considering the situation, permission to even withdraw 25% of the decretal amount on furnishing usual undertaking is granted.
5. The application stands disposed of.
