- 2) The applicants/respondents No.3 to 5 have moved this application to permit them to withdraw the amount lying in this Court, for which learned counsel for the appellant has objected.
- 3) Having considered the facts of the case and perusal of the impugned judgment, I do not find substance in his objection; hence, the application is partly allowed. The applicants are permitted to withdraw 50% of the total compensation amount along with accrued interest thereon, on furnishing a usual undertaking to the satisfaction of the Registry.
- 4) The Registrar (J) is directed to transfer 50% of the total compensation amount lying in this Court along with interest accrued thereon in the bank account of the respective applicants, as per the award, on their furnishing a usual undertaking and their bank details to the Registry within four weeks.
