2. The prayer is for refund of return.

3. The counsel for the respondents submits that the order under Section 143(1) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, has been passed on 29/01/2024.

4. The Assessing Officer has held that the refund is not payable to the assessee.

5. The counsel for the petitioner submits that this order was never supplied to the petitioner, and therefore, was unaware of the same. Accordingly, seeks permission to challenge the order before the appropriate forum. Leave granted.

6. The petitioner, if so desired, shall prefer appeal within four weeks from today. The appeal, if filed, shall be decided as expeditiously as possible and preferably within four months from the date of presentation of the appeal.
