2. The applicants/respondent Nos. 1 A to 1 E have moved this application to permit them to withdraw the amount deposited by the appellant, for which learned counsel for the appellant has no objection, as the first appeal was dismissed on 08.05.2024.

3. It further appears that applicants No. 1A to 1D have executed a power of attorney in favour of applicant No. 1(E) and thereby authorized applicant No. 1(E) to collect the amount on their behalf.
