Vide orders dated 20-12-2023 passed in Criminal Writ Petition No. 502/2023 and 18-7-2023 passed in Criminal Writ Petition No. 426/2023, the Court permitted the investigation to go on but to file charge-sheet after obtaining leave of the Court. The investigating agency intends to file 'A' summary and accordingly, applications are filed seeking permission to file summary.

3. In our view, such permission is not required because the Court's order was to seek permission if
