Applicants/respondents No. 1-A to 1-C have filed this application to permit them to withdraw the entire compensation amount deposited by the appellants before the executing Court/CJSD, Yavatmal, with their proportionate share, along with interest, for which learned counsel for appellants has no objection subject to furnishing undertaking by the applicants before the executing Court. Learned AGP for respondents No. 2 and 3 has no objection to such withdrawal.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants submitted that respondent Nos. 1A to 1C are the sons of the deceased Sheshrao; therefore, he prayed to grant an equal share to all the applicants along with interest.

4. Having considered the reasons disclosed in the application as well as the no objection of learned counsel for appellants and learned AGP, the application is allowed, as prayed.

5. In view of the above, the learned Reference Court is directed to transfer the amount of compensation in equal proportion into the bank account of the applicants along with accrued interest thereon, within four weeks, on their furnishing the usual undertaking and bank account details to them. The application is disposed of.
