2. *Issue notice to the respondents returnable on 25.07.2025.*

3. *Learned A.P.P. waive service of notice for the respondents.*

4. *While granting relief of parole on the ground that the petitioner's mother is suffering from Cancer, respondent No.2 has imposed a condition to deposit Rs.2,00,000/- towards cash security which, in our view, would amount to denial of relief granted to the petitioner, particularly considering the fact that the petitioner is a labourer.*

5. *Learned APP shall take instructions and make statement tomorrow.”*

2. Learned APP submits that the petitioner has moved an application to reduce the cash surety amount to Rs. 20,000/-, and accordingly, the amount has been reduced.

3. Learned counsel appearing for petitioner submits that with the reduction in cash surety, the purpose of filing petition has been served.
