2. The applicant/respondent Nos. 1-A, 1-B, 2, 4 and 5 have filed this application to permit them to withdraw a balance of 50% amount along with accrued interest thereon, for which learned counsel for appellant has no objection to withdraw 25% amount on usual undertaking.
