CIVIL APPLICATIONS (O) NO. 792 & 793 OF 2025

1) The applicant/appellant has filed these applications to condone the delay of 120 days caused in filing the application to restore the Civil Applications No.2673/2023 and 2674/2023 for bringing legal heirs of respondent No.10 on record against the proposed legal heir respondent No.10(iii) by setting aside the same, as well as to set aside the order dated 18/02/2025, passed by learned Registrar (J), as against the proposed legal heir respondent No.10(iii).
