1. By way of this revision, the applicant challenges the conviction and order of sentenced passed by the Judicial Magistrate First Class in S.C.C No. 638/2018, which was confirmed by the Extra Joint Additional Sessions Judge, Achalpur.

2. During the pendency of this revision, both parties have arrived at a settlement, wherein party No.1 has agreed to pay Rs. 2,60,000/-. Out of which the amount of Rs.1,30,000/- has already been deposited before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Daryapur, and Rs.30,000/- was deposited by party No.1 before the Sessions Court, Achalpur. The remaining amount of Rs. 1,00,000/- was to be deposited within one month from the date of the settlement. The applicant has accordingly deposited the said amount and filed a Pursis to that effect, along with receipt.

In view of the settlement, the matter is to be disposed of by acquitting the accused.

3. Learned counsel for both the parties are present. Learned counsel for the non-applicant submitted that, in view of the Pursis, the matter may be disposed of.

4. In view of that, the criminal revision is **disposed of** by acquitting the accused.

5. The non-applicant is at liberty to withdraw the amount on due identification and verification.
