- 2) The petitioner has challenged the order dated 06/03/2024 passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Amravati in Case No./LND-18/KARANJA WASHIM/01/2021-2022 and the order dated 20/10/2021 passed by the Collector, Washim.
- 3) Learned Assistant Government Pleader for the State submitted that the petitioner is having alternate and equally efficacious remedy to file appeal/revision under the provisions of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code.
