3. The contention is that the issue involved in all
these writ petitions is common and that being so, the

petition by directing the respondents to reconsider the

directions issued by the State Government in Government
Resolution dated 01.07.2011.

effect within a period of six weeks from today and

communicate the same to the petitioner.

In case, if it is held that the petitioner is entitled for the benefits, in such an eventuality, the consequential financial benefits be extended to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of such order.
