2. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable after one week.
3. Shri A.B. Nakshane, learned Counsel waives service of notice for respondent No.1.
4. Mrs. M.R. Kavimandan, learned AGP waives service of notice for respondent Nos.2 and 3.
5. By this application, the applicant is seeking condonation of 249 days in filing the application for restoration of appeal. According to the appellant, the paper book is ready and same can be filed before this Court within
