- 1) Heard learned counsel for the respective parties.
- 2) The petitioners challenge the order dated 19/12/2018 passed by the Additional Divisional Commissioner, Amravati in Revision No. 17/RTS-64/Chandrapur/2005-2006.
- 3) Learned Assistant Government Pleader submits that the petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy to challenge the same by filing revision before the State Government under Section 257 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966. In support of his submission, he relied upon the judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court in ***Gurudassing Nawoosingh Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and Ors. reported in 2015(6) Mh.L.J. 915.***
- 4) In view of that, the petition is disposed as not maintainable. The petitioner is at liberty to challenge the impugned order before the State Government within a period of four weeks from today. The time spent in prosecuting the present writ petition to be taken into consideration by the State Government while deciding revision. The State Government to

decide the proceedings within a period of two months thereafter. The petitioner is at liberty to place any additional document on record before the State Government, and same be considered on its own merit. The interim order granted earlier to continue till the decision or until another application is moved before the competent authority. No order as to costs.
