1. Heard Shri P.N. Varma, learned counsel for the petitioners. He has pointed out that in spite of the petitioners having not passed the examination of Driver-cum-Conductor, subsequently they were employed for a particular period. He requests this Court that if the direction is given to the respondent-Authorities to consider the petitioners' representation, grievance raised in this petition would be redressed.
