- 2) The petitioner has challenged the order dated 20/05/2022 passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Amravati in Appeal No.APT/5/6/Akola/2021-22 and the order dated 25/08/2021 passed by the District Collector, Akola.
- 3) Learned Assistant Government Pleader for the State submitted that the petitioner is having alternate and equally efficacious remedy to file appeal/revision under the provisions of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code.
- 4) In that view of the matter, the petition stands disposed of as not maintainable. The petitioner is at liberty to challenge the orders passed by both the Authorities before the State Government within a period of four weeks from today.
