- 4) In view thereof, the matter is referred to mediation. By consent of the learned counsel for the parties, Advocate Mr.J.J.Chandurkar is hereby appointed as Mediator. The parties to appear before the learned Mediator. Learned Mediator is requested to submit a report after mediation is concluded.
