1. Heard learned Counsel for the applicant and learned Assistant Government Pleader for respondents.
2. Present application is filed for condonation of delay caused for filing of restoration application in writ petition which was dismissed on 30.09.2024. There is a delay of 38 days.
3. It is contention of the applicant that due to inadvertence the office objections could not be removed within time prescribed by the Registrar (Judicial). As such, registration of the Writ Petition (Stamp) No.10730/2024 was refused.
