On instructions, learned Counsel for petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the petition as it was filed when the elections had just been undertaken and Ministry Portfolios have not been allocated that is the post was vacant and in view thereof, he could not challenge, though remedy of appeal was there before the State Government. The petitioner seeks direction to the State Government to consider his application for condonation of delay, in view of this peculiar facts. As such, petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

the application for condonation of delay. The State Government may consider his application for condonation of delay on its own merit.

3. State Government is further directed to decide the appeal as expeditiously as possible, as per provisions of Section 39(3) of the Maharashtra Village Panchayat Act.
