1. Heard Mr. Tejas Deshpande, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. A.G. Mate, learned AGP for respondent/State.
2. The petitioner is challenging the order dated 01.11.2023 passed by the Additional Commissioner, Amravati in Revision No.294/RTS-59/Vivekanand Nagar/2018-2019 and order dated 11.09.2018 passed by the Additional Collector, Buldhana in Appeal No.RTS-59/Vivekanand Nagar/67/2016-2017.
3. The petitioner is having an alternate and equally efficacious remedy against the orders passed by the Additional Commissioner, Amravati and Additional Collector, Buldhana to file a revision before the State Government and this issue is already considered by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the matter *Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra and*

Others reported in *2015 AIR SCW 6277 SUPREME COURT* decided on *06.11.2015*. In view thereof, the writ petition is **disposed of** as not maintainable. No order as to costs.

4. The petitioner may file revision before the State Government within a period of six weeks. Delay caused in prosecuting the present writ petition be taken into consideration while considering the application for condonation of delay.
